



## Ballabourneen 2011 Gamay Noir

Immediately intriguing with its wonderful garnet colour, this tantalising Beaujolais-style red is the perfect entrée to spring/summer drinking.

Aromas of cherries fresh off the tree, mixed with a little tar and violets, suggest a roadside picnic in the French countryside! While dry and savoury on the palate, there is a touch of cherry sweetness to ensure the fruit flavours linger all the way to the finish.

Throw me a baguette, some herbed roast chicken, homemade aioli, sun-dried tomato with baby spinach leaves, a Ballabourneen Gamay Noir, and I'm in heaven!

And if you really HAVE to stay inside, cook up some sweet chilli salmon and see the sparks fly with this wine ...
